

### **Validation of a Granted European Patent in Ireland**

If a European Patent is granted in English, and designates Ireland, the patent is automatically validated in Ireland. It is advisable that a local address for service and Authorisation of Agent requirements should still be met.

European Patents granted in German or French are **not** automatically validated in Ireland. Ireland has not yet ratified the London Agreement with regard to filing translation of the claims only at the Irish Patents office. Therefore in order for a French or German language European Patent to be validated in Ireland, the following steps must be taken within **6 months** of the European grant date:

- filing of a full certified/verified English translation of the specification;
- filing a Authorisation of Agent, executed by the patentee;
- payment of a Patent Office fee of €35; and
- nomination of an Address for Service in Ireland.
